Description

EMTs provide basic medical care including evaluation, treatment and stabilization to the ill and injured at the scene of a medical emergency or other traumatic event. An EMT has a comprehensive knowledge base and is able to provide the highest standard of patient care in the most appropriate and efficient manner for a broad range of medical and traumatic emergencies.

Applicants must hold an EMT-B or EMT-P license from the Illinois Department of Public Health, or be able to obtain a license with a National Registry Certification. All successful applicants must complete all educational requirements of the Quincy Area EMS System within 6 months of acceptance. Additionally, applicants must have a valid driver's license in their state of residence.
